**Are you ready for the big change?**

From July 2011 your garbage and recycling collection is going to change. You will have a new 140L red bin for your general waste and your 240L bin will become your recycling bin.

All recycling can be mixed together in the 240L bin. Please remember to rinse containers, and only clean items to be put into your recycling.

**What can be recycled:** paper, newspaper, brochures, cardboard, glass bottles, glass jars, steel cans, aerosol cans, aluminum cans, plastic milk bottles, plastic soft drink bottles, plastic containers and plastic bags.

**What you CANNOT recycle includes:** food waste, garden clippings, ceramics, crockery, cookware, long life containers, medical waste, syringes, disposable nappies and waste oil containers.
