



Disposal of asbestos waste

Council has strict conditions for the acceptance of asbestos waste at the Uralla Waste Management Facility. It is essential customers follow directions before and during disposal to avoid asbestos exposure to themselves, staff and other people.

Please note asbestos waste is not accepted at any other Waste Management Facility in the Council area (Bundarra, Kingstown or Kentucky).

Conditions of entry and disposal

To dispose of asbestos waste at Uralla Waste Management Facility, the following conditions must be met:

- Bookings for disposal must be made before entry
- You must arrive on time for your appointment
- Asbestos waste must wetted and sealed in heavy-duty plastic and secured with strong tape
- On arrival at the facility, an Application to Dispose of Asbestos Form must be completed
- Persons disposing of asbestos must ensure they follow all disposal procedures and the directions of staff at the facility

For asbestos quantities greater than 100kg or 10 square metres:

- Asbestos weighing more than 100kg or consisting of more than 10 square metres of sheeting in one load must be accompanied by a consignment number.
- You must provide the consignment number using the WasteLocate app and scan the QR code at the landfill gatehouse.
- Ensure compliance with the NSW EPA's WasteLocate tracking requirements (refer to NSW EPA web page http://www.epa.nsw.gov.au/wasteregulation/wastelocate-asbestos.htm)

The following is not permitted

- Delivery of asbestos which is inadequately wrapped, un-bagged asbestos or otherwise improperly presented
- Unloading asbestos in a manner which may break open the plastic wrapping
- Tipping asbestos from the back of your vehicle
- · Not following the directions of staff.

How to book in asbestos waste for disposal

Asbestos waste is accepted by appointment only

- Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday 8:00am to 3:00pm
- Not on Wednesday, Saturday, Sunday or public holidays
- To make a booking for asbestos waste disposal at Uralla Waste Management Facility, please phone (02) 6778 6300 at least 24 hours in advance
- You will need to supply your name, address, phone number, date of disposal and approximately how much asbestos waste you have for disposal
- For small domestic scale amounts of asbestos, residents must purchase an asbestos bag from the Council facility prior to disposal
- For larger amounts of asbestos, notify Council of the intention to dispose of asbestos at the site, with quote provided on request.

If the conditions outlined in this Fact Sheet are not followed for the disposal of asbestos waste at the Uralla Waste Management Facility, you may be in breach of the NSW Protection of the Environment Operations Act 1997 and Protection of the Environment Operations (Waste) Regulation 2014 and could be liable for penalties.
