### Extraordinary Meeting of 16 October 2013

The General Manager provided Council with an update on the progress of the Audit.

The field work of the Audit was concluded over the period Tuesday 22 to Thursday 24 October 2013.

The discussions between the Auditor, Mr Paul Cornall and the General Manager were in respect to the classification of the funding of the Community Services Contracts, the treatment of incorrect prior year depreciation and prior year Employee Leave Entitlement provision adjustments.

The Auditor has agreed with the classification of Tablelands Community Support Options (TCSO) and Kamilaroi Aged and Disabled Services (KADS) funding as Contract Service Fees in User Fees and Charges. However, as the Auditor has determined that the funding for McMaugh Gardens Aged Care Centre (McMaughs) and Tablelands Community Transport (TCT) are subsidies, not fees, these are to be classified as Contributions in Grants and Contributions.

When Roads were re-valued at 30 June 2009, the NESAC Finance Team included the valuation of 24.64 Kilometres of Thunderbolts Way in both Guyra and Uralla Shire Council's Asset Registers. The section belongs to Guyra and Uralla Shire Council has been charging \$92,276.80 each year from 2009/2010 to 2011/2012 in error.

The Council's treatment of the depreciation writeback for 2009/2010 to 2011/1012 of the 24.64 Kilometres of Thunderbolt Way by reducing the 2012/2013 depreciation was not agreed to by the Auditor. The \$276,830.40 reduction of depreciation is to be an adjustment of prior years. This has altered the draft surplus of \$256,464.22 to a deficit of \$20,366.18 for 2012/2013.

The Auditor agreed that the basis on which Council had treated the writeback of depreciation, the additional Employee Leave Entitlement (ELE) provision adjustment in the 2012 Income Statement due to an error from 2009, was also wrong and should have been an adjustment of prior years and not a charge in 2011/2012.

The adjustment to prior years of \$439,500.08 ELE provision and the \$92,276.80 of the Thunderbolt Way depreciation will reduce the 2011/2012 comparative deficit from \$569,000.00 to \$37,000.00.
