SUMMARY:

This motion seeks to rectify an oversight which occurred when developing the proposed motion and subsequent resolution about Council fees and charges at the June 2018 Ordinary Meeting.

COUNCILLOR'S MOTION:

That Council remove the following items and associated fees/charges contained immediately below the sub-heading “Uncontaminated Garden and Wood Waste” of the Fees and Charges, adopted by Resolution No. 11.06/18:

- 1. Car/Sedan/Wagon/4x4 domestic**
- 2. Utility/6x4 trailer**
- 3. Commercial**

Background

At its meeting of 26th June 2018, Council resolved not to charge fees for uncontaminated gardens and wood waste contained within wheelie bins (up to 240 l) taken (by private means) to the Uralla Waste Management Facility (UWMF). Unfortunately, due to the extent of business which was discussed in relation to the budget at the June meeting, the full extent of proposed change to the advertised fees was not recorded in the draft motion and the subsequent resolution.

The intent of the change, discussed at the workshop before the meeting and also during the meeting, was the removal of all fees/charges for uncontaminated garden and wood waste deposited (by private means – i.e. not as a result of Council’s green waste collection service) to the UWMF.

This motion seeks to rectify that oversight.
